# "Keep On Truckin" To Pick Up My C8



Several people have told me if I ever had the opportunity, I should take delivery of my Vette at the National Corvette Museum because it was just fantastic and that's was my plan. After placing my order 1-1/2 years ago, I finally got the call that my Torch Red Corvette convertible was being produced and I could arrange a pickup time 2 weeks from actual completion date. Shane Webb, the Delivery Department Manager, texted me and I picked a time slot of 9:30am on April 1.

Did you know you can't get there from here? Who knew? Flying wasn't an option at the time, and I had always thought when the time came I would just rent a car, NOT!! One cannot rent a car one-way from the Villages to Bowling Green Kentucky, only one company did say they had one for over \$1,600...I thought that was



ridiculous.. then I went into absolute panic mode wondering how, after all this time, I was going to get there....hmmmm...then it hit me, U-Hauls are one way!! Another hitch, they don't rent panel vans one-way apparently, only trucks, so I began my journey in a 15ft U-haul truck.

I arrived safely in Bowling Green the day before April 1, and my son flew down from Oklahoma City for this momentous occasion and that truly made it even more special as I hadn't seen him in over a year. I was up bright and early the morning of April 1, and watched on their web cam as my "baby" was the first one of 8 to be driven onto Corvette Blvd., for pickup. I was giddy with excitement and could hardly wait for the appointed time. We got there early and were met by John Witter our delivery guy and he was so warm and welcoming, felt like we had known him forever. John and Lori took care of my paperwork while I oogled, at last, my corvette. There were red ropes around my car and a placard on the stand with my name, I felt so special, like a rock star. The rock star treatment is exactly what we got. John spent over 2 hours demonstrating all the features of my car and explaining in detail how everything worked, and to my surprise, it had a retractable top. I had no idea. I was thinking it was another lift off, so this feature added to my excitement. As many of you know I have a 2016 Torch red Z++.06 with lift off top and after almost 7 years, it's only been off once, and George Borke helped take it off at a function a couple of years ago. Now, I could put the top down whenever I wanted!!! Good times!!! Only thing I didn't see was the engine, lol.

John gave us a personalized tour of the museum and told many interesting and funny stories associated with each of the cars, too numerous to mention (not that I could remember them anyways)...just amazing. The cars that fell into the sinkhole, were on display (or what was left of them) and it was a sickening sight..only one car was ever rebuilt.

Even though there's a Corvette shop, we only bought small things and ordered larger items online as there were 2 of us with luggage for the drive back to The Villages. Unfortunately, the restaurant wasn't open because of COVID and they were taking that opportunity to revamp.

The day drew to a close and our exit was definitely rock star quality. John gave several short blasts of the horn and we began our exit slowly down Corvette Blvd. to the applause and cheers of all personnel and visitors until we exited the building. One feature of the car is that it records so I have this as my first video to review any time I wish. Talk about feeling special, well I guess we Corvette owners are in a way, for we are fortunate enough to drive America's dream sports car.

This experience was incredible, amazing, fantastic, once in a lifetime and the most exciting 5 hours of my life. The entire staff is geared toward making it a special event and my opinion, went above and beyond. I can recommend museum delivery as it truly is a "once in a lifetime experience."


