VETS IN YETTES IN THE VILLAGES

MIKE AND LINDA WHITE'S SHARED INTEREST IN CORVETTES LED TO LOVE BOTH ON AND OFF THE TRACK

For Mike and Linda White, owning Corvettes led to more than just social opportunities and track days. Both members of the Village Vettes Club, the pair met and fell in love through the club and their mutual interest in Corvettes.

Mike moved to the area in 2006, and he joined the Village Vettes shortly after.

"When I got here, I was still working and I needed a break, so I joined the club," he said. "I did all kinds of stuff and I was pretty active, and in 2008, the club sponsored a Daytona trip. I had seen Linda at meetings before — she said I was leering at her, but I wasn't (laughs)."

While on the trip, the club went to dinner after spending the day on the Daytona International Speedway, and Linda jokingly told the waiter to send her bill over to Mike.

"I said OK and just paid it," Mike said, laughing. "That's how we met, and we were married less than a year later. That's our story."

"He just couldn't wait," Linda added with a laugh.

Speaking of "leering," Mike said he had previously seen Linda at club meetings but had never talked to her much.

"I'd see her at the club and all that, but I never approached her," Mike said. "Every once in a while we would talk, but it was al-

ways about something military. We went to some activity (with the club), and she said, 'You said you were going to call me!' I told her I would, and she said, 'Well when? Two years from now?' So I asked her to breakfast and the rest is history."

Both Mike and Linda are retired Army veterans, and that shared military experience often was a topic they talked about at club meets.

"She's a retired sergeant major and I'm a retired colonel," Mike said. "And she still doesn't listen to me (laughs)."

Linda says owning a Corvette helped her forge her own path in the Army — people knew who she was and they respected the woman driving the red Corvette.

"It was good back then when I had my little red 'Vette," Linda said.

"When I was in the military, the big shots were like, 'Who is that?' And I'd wave hi and just keep on going. It was a lot of fun, it helped me roll around in the military."













The pair previously owned separate Corvettes, but after getting married, they decided to trade in the other cars for a single Corvette — a C6 Corvette, or the sixth generation of the legendary American car. Eventually though, they traded up to a C7 — a 2016 Corvette Stingray convertible with the Z51 Performance Package, their current car.

New Corvette owners can register for the Ron Fellows Performance Driving School in Las Vegas, and after purchasing the 2016 Corvette, Mike and Linda enrolled in the school.

There, they had a blast on the track, learning the ins and outs of their new car.

"You're on the track 80% of the time," Mike said. "(The instructors are) professional

drivers, and they're on the radio telling you you didn't hit your apex or to speed it up or go down a gear. Over the speaker, I hear, 'Hey! Get over there!' It was Linda on the radio. That was all I needed."

While Mike was driving, Linda rode with the pro drivers at the front of the pack and she was able to use the radio to talk to Mike. "(The driver) said, 'Do you see him back there?' And I said, 'I know, he's not doing very well,'" Linda recalled. "He handed me the radio and said, 'There, say something to him.' Those guys were so nice, and we had the best time there."

Since joining the Village Vettes in 2006, Mike has held ev-

ery position with the club with the exception of treasurer. He is heavily involved with the club, and he enjoys the camaraderie shared by members of the club.

"He works his butt off, I can tell you that," Linda said.

The Village Vettes meet on the second Thursday of every month at Eisenhower Regional Recreation Center, and Mike says they do several fundraising drives and charity

events throughout the year that he helps put together.

For Mike and Linda, Corvettes and the Village Vettes club have led to lasting friendships and even a new relationship. Now, cruising around The Villages with the top down and the radio on has become a way of life.

"The best way I can describe it — when I get in my
'Vette, a smile immediately comes over my face," Mike said.
"Life is good. And Corvette people are great people. They're
very effervescent, and they're just fun-loving people. They
also have big hearts — it's a great combination."
